2022 was a historic year for The Neighbors' Place! It was our final year at 745 Scott Street. After several decades of proudly serving our community in a variety of impactful ways, it was time for us to pack up and move to our new home located inside The Community Partners' Campus, 360 Grand Avenue, Wausau.

Over the last year as we were winding down our operations, we continued to serve those in need by keeping our outdoor distribution going strong and growing our delivery service to homebound residents. In addition, our newest program, The Babies' Place, continued to address diaper need throughout Marathon County as we worked to collaborate with more partners serving families in need of this vital resource.

As Covid began to diminish, we faced other new and daunting challenges. The PFAS issue prompted us to quickly secure safe drinking water for families who could not obtain water on their own. Collaborating with the United Way and the city, we were able to quickly incorporate water into our food distribution.

The Baby Formula shortage was another challenge we tackled. We worked tirelessly to procure as much formula as we could and to distribute it as equitably as possible. Although the shortage continues, the situation is improving, and we are continuing to keep baby formula on the shelves for our most vulnerable guests!

Despite these challenges, we were able to keep our operations going strong thanks to the generosity of this community, our many dedicated volunteers, board members, staff, our community partners, and I would be remiss if I didn't mention our sincere gratitude to the local media for their coverage of these events and their vital role in keeping residents informed and up to date.

We will continue to meet immediate needs and collaborate with organizations across Marathon County to bring solutions to the underserved, give a voice to those without, and get to the root causes of hunger.


